Head of the State: President

The President is elected by secret vote for five-years term. In October 9, 2013 **Ilham Haydar Aliyev** was elected as the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, after acquiring of votes of 3 126 113 persons or 84,54% of electorates in the elections.

The Legislative Authority of the Republic of Azerbaijan is implemented by the National Assembly (Milli Mejlis) of the Republic of Azerbaijan. The National Assembly of the Republic of Azerbaijan consist of 125 deputies. The fourth call an election to the National Assembly was held on November 1, 2015.
