POPULATION BY SEX AND AGE: GIBRALTAR 1961, 1970, 1981







OFFICIAL SECTOR WEEKLY PAID EMPLOYEES BY SEX




OFFICIAL SECTOR MONTHLY EMPLOYEES BY SEX



PRIVATE SECTOR MONTHLY EMPLOYEES BY SEX













NEW REGISTRATIONS 1976-1988







No. of Persons (000's)



