Chart 2.02 Civilian Population of Gibraltar, 1961, 1970, 1981, 1991, 2001 and 2012













Distribution of Households by the Number of Persons and the Number of Rooms per Household, 2012









Industrial Accidents by Nature of Injury, 2015












Total Visitor Arrivals by Air, 2015










Total Gross Tonnage Arriving at Gibraltar, 2015






Chart 18.04 Monthly Maximum and Minimum Air Temperatures, 2014 - 2015



