

I N T R O D U C T I O N

This is the twenty-second annual Abstract of Statistics to be published. The Abstract is a well established and widely used source of economic and social statistics on Gibraltar.

The object of the Abstract is to provide a selection of statistics, in a one compact volume, on topics of interest. The tables contain notes and definitions which should be read, particularly if the statistics are to be used and interpreted properly. Further information on these statistics may be obtained from the Statistics Office on written application. Suggestions on future editions are welcome and will be considered.

Unless otherwise stated the source of information in the report is the Statistics Office.

It is hoped that the Abstract offers a useful feedback of the information which is collected and processed by the Statistics Office.



Percentages shown above are out of the Total Civilian Population














I.R.P. ALL ITEMS



I.R.P. (FOOD GROUP)



IMPORTS FROM E.U. COUNTRIES 1994








No. of Persons (000's)



SCHEDULED 1972 - 1994



